Some FAQs

- What's required of leaders and chaperones for RYM?
 - All chaperones/leaders must be 18 years of age or older and submit to RYM proof of a national background check AND completion of a ministry safe child sexual abuse awareness training course.
- What leader:student ratio does RYM recommend?
 - RYM requires a leader:student ratio of at least 1:10 by gender.
 However, each group is unique, and RYM recommends a ratio closer to 1:6.

- How will leaders and students be housed?
 - Leaders and students will be housed by gender and by group. Girls will tend to be housed in smaller "homes" while the guys will oftentimes be bunked in larger quarters.
- What activities will be available?
 - Swimming (multiple pools & open ocean), Gaga Ball, Spike Ball,
 Basketball, Volleyball, Ping Pong, Kan Jam, Sand Soccer, Card Games,
 Paddle Boarding/Kayaking (which requires an extra waiver/payment)
- Will our kids need to bring cash?
 - o If they would like to spend money at the book table, gift shop, snack shop, or if their group is planning a night out, yes.
